NEET Super Speciality 2017: Application form Exam Date Eligibility

NEET SS 2017 Examination conducting for the admission in advance courses like DM, MCH, PDCC. NEET SS (Super Speciality) 2017 will be organised by the National Board of Examination. NBE said, "As per the Indian Medical Council Act 1956/10 NEET SS (Super Speciality) 2017 will be organised.

NEET SS (Super Speciality) 2017 examination will be Computer Based Exam (CBT). NEET SS (Super Speciality) 2017 Exam composed 200 multiple choice questions related to the courses. As per the Indian Medical Council Act 1956/10, any other exam will not be included.

But AIIMS (New Delhi), PGIMER (Chandigarh), Shri Chitra (Thiruvananthapuram), NIMHANS (Bangluru), JIPMER and Pondicherry in not include in NEET SS (Super Speciality) 2017 Examination.

Scope of Examination

NEET-SS will serve as a single window entrance examination for admission to DM/M.ch/PDCC courses. No other entrance examination either at the State level or any Institutional level exam conducted by any University or medical colleges will be applicable in accordance to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 with effect from 2017 admission session.

NEET-SS will serve as the sole gateway for admission to Super Specialty Courses which include the following:

- DM/M.ch/PDCC courses at all Private Medical Colleges/Deemed Universities/Institutions & Universities across the nation
- DM/M.ch/PDCC courses at Armed Forces Medical Service Institutions
- **Scheme of NEET-SS 2017**
- NEET-SS 2017 will be organized in all specialities. Candidates possessing MD/MS/DNB degree are eligible for pursuing Super-Speciality courses in the nation.
- A candidate is allowed to appear for NEET-SS in one discipline of eligible entry level qualification.

- **Exceptions to NEET-SS 2017/States Exempted from NEET-SS**
- NEET-SS will serve as the sole gateway for admission to DM/M.ch Super Speciality courses in the nation. No other entrance examination either at the State or the Institutional level will be applicable for entry to DM/M.ch courses according to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 with effect from 2017 Admission session.
- Qualifying NEET-SS will be mandatory for gaining admission to Super-Speciality courses under various universities/institutions in the nation.
- No State Government/Private Medical Colleges/Universities are exempted from NEET-SS.
